**Opposition Coalition Letter AB 701 (Gonzalez) Warehouse Distribution Centers  
Oppose/Job Killer- As Amended May 17, 2021**

In accordance with the attached signed coalition letter as drafted by The California Chamber Of Commerce; The Yorba Linda Chamber Of Commerce requests that our distinguished representatives in the California Legislature oppose Assembly Bill 701.

Assembly Bill 701 is obviously focused on limiting the harsh work conditions that are associated with quotas. Such a phenomenon is particularly associated with major corporations like Amazon and Walmart who house multiple facilities within our great state. The chamber has no doubt that Assemblymember Gonzalez seeks to improve the work conditions for these employees, but doing so at the additional peril of our small businesses is not only unnecessary, but also detrimental to those still rebuilding from COVID-19. This chamber supports limiting unattainable quotas and promoting better work conditions for the employees of these major corporations, but our immediate focus lies in the hands of our members and small businesses who are not responsible for these quotas and conditions, but instead only bear their burden.

For the reasons mentioned, The Yorba Linda Chamber Of Commerce Opposes AB 701, unless amended to limit the fallout on our members and small businesses alike.
